Important show notes:

There is no entry fee to enter the show.

Confirmed entrants:

- Will be advised of their display space location in the hall before the event.
- Will receive two free adult weekend passes to CRC Speedshow and a free car park pass (exact parking area to be confirmed), and a complimentary goodie bag from show organisers with products and vouchers donated by sponsors and other relevant organisations (these will be handed out to entrants when signing in at registration during pack-in).
- Will cover all their own costs.
- All entrants are encouraged to set up a display around their vehicle.
- All cars will be judged and the winners in the various classes (see page two) will receive a trophy and a prize package of items donated by sponsors. The class winners are also eligible for the following awards:
